Our organisation works with people who have experienced mental illness and provides assistance to individuals to enable them achieve their personal goals as a means to empowerment and full community participation.

Our recovery service is a unique and exciting program focusing on the evidence-based psychiatric rehabilitation model developed by Boston University.

Aspire is seeking two full-time staff members for its established program operating out of the Hobart office and providing service to the Southern region of Tasmania, and one fulltime position in the Northern region (Launceston based) to cover a vacancy arising from maternity leave to 30 June 2011.

Requirements: applicants will have successfully completed health/welfare training at University or Polytechnic level (e.g. Social Work, Psychology, Nursing, and Welfare). Experience in the provision of services to people with a mental illness will be highly regarded, as will other relevant knowledge and experience in case management and rehabilitation.

The successful applicants will demonstrate a commitment to working from an empowering framework to form successful working partnerships with people who experience a mental illness, and other key stakeholders. High level interpersonal skills, the ability to work autonomously, and a current drivers license, are essential. Applicants will be asked to submit to a national and state police check.

Employment conditions and pay rates will be in accordance with the Victorian SACS award and dependent on qualifications and experience. Aspire provides staff with salary packaging options and excellent work conditions which contributes to an attractive package and an exciting career opportunity.
